According to the law, males must register with Selective Service within 30 days of their 18th birthday. Selective Services will not accept registration from men 26 years old or older. Men who did not register for selective services during the time they were eligible can be denied Federal financial aid, Federal job training or Federal employment.

Non-registrants may appeal if he can “show by a preponderance of evidence” that failure to register was not knowing and willful. Non-registrants must offer as much evidence supporting their claim with as much detail as possible.
