The *Emma Lou Thayne Civically-Engaged Scholarship* will be awarded to a returning student with significant experience in service, community activities, and/or civic engagement. The scholarship covers tuition and fees for 2009-10. During the year the student receives the scholarship, the recipient will assume a leadership role with the Thayne Center for Service & Learning, working on a variety of service initiatives. A minimum of eight hours a week is required during each semester. Finalists for the scholarship will go through an interview process.

Students must meet the following qualifications for consideration:

- Returning SLCC student (must have completed at least 12 credits at SLCC)
- Full-time enrollment (12 credits or more)
- Minimum GPA of 3.0
- Utah resident and citizen of the United States
- Copy of SLCC transcript
- Two letters of recommendation from individuals other than family who are familiar with your service/civic engagement activities, such as a service-learning professor or a representative from a community agency
- Two-page written essay on the following topic: What does the term, “civic engagement,” mean to you, and how have you demonstrated this through your own activities?
